Rosen** will be honored by the Rutgers Law School-Camden Alumni Association with the 2026 Honorable Joseph M. Nardi Jr. Distinguished Service Award. The award recognizes Rutgers Law graduates who have achieved an extraordinary level of success through their legal and professional expertise, outstanding service to the Law School, and/or exemplary community leadership.

Debra will receive the award at the Gov. James J. Florio Scholarship Benefit and Distinguished Alumni Awards Ceremony on Thursday, October 22, at The Merion. The Honorable Joseph M. Nardi Jr. Distinguished Service Award commemorates the life and accomplishments of the late Superior Court Judge, former Camden Mayor, and 1956 Rutgers Law graduate.

Debra has built a distinguished 40-year legal career at Archer, where she concentrates her practice in complex environmental and toxic tort litigation, as well as environmental due diligence and compliance. commitment to community service was previously recognized when she received the Camden County Distinguished Citizen Award from the Garden State Council, Scouting America.

Debra has also been recognized for her dedication to mentorship and professional excellence. In 2023, she was named a “Mentor” honoree in the New Jersey Legal Awards. For the past two years, she has been recognized in *The Best Lawyers in America*® in both Environmental Law and Environmental Litigation, and in the 2027 edition, was named “Lawyer of the Year” in Cherry Hill for both categories. Debra was also honored by the Executive Women of New Jersey at its 2024 Salute to Policy Makers, recognizing leading women in business, government and academia. She has also been recognized by New Jersey Super Lawyers for Environmental Litigation nine times and has been ranked by Chambers USA in the area of Environmental Law for the past five years.
