A charity tennis match on Sept. 19, 2009, will benefit My Brother’s Keeper homeless shelter in Camden, N.J., pitting Camden City Council President Angel Fuentes and former Camden County Prosecutor Vincent P. Sarubbi against New Jersey State Sen. James Beach and Camden City Clerk Luis Pastoriza.

The doubles match takes place at 10 a.m. at the Rutgers University-Camden outdoor courts at 2nd and Pearl Streets in Camden, N.J. The shelters provide Bible classes, Narcotics Anonymous meetings, computer lessons and meals of donated food, which the men help to cook.

The doubles match is part of the Sixth Annual Fuentes’ Tennis Charity Event, sponsored by the City Council President.
