

## Steven K. Mignogna Presents Seminar for Philadelphia Estate Planning Council

Steven K. Mignogna, Chair of the Estate & Trust Litigation Group at the law firm of Archer P.C., accepted an invitation to speak to the Philadelphia Estate Planning Council (PEPC). Mr. Mignogna presented the seminar, *Gifts Gone Awry*, on May 17, 2012, at the offices of BNY Mellon in Philadelphia.

Mr. Mignogna provided information about the variety of reasons that can cause donative transfers to go awry, such as drafting problems as to the terms, impractical restrictions, changed circumstances, and economic pressures. An increasing number of cases – often prominent – have spiked the need for awareness of these problems and options for solving them. Mr. Mignogna presented a survey of these problems and solutions, as well as the concepts that apply when disputes arise, and elucidated on the procedural and substantive challenges unique to this area of litigation.
