

Employees Donate Baby Shower Items for Wives of Wounded Warriors

The law firm of Archer P.C. and its employees recently donated a variety of baby care items for a special group of mothers-to-be – pregnant wives of wounded military personnel being treated at the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in Bethesda, Md.

WRNMMC is the largest military medical center in the United States, caring for the wounded, ill and injured from conflicts around the world. Currently 108 pregnant wives are staying at their husbands' bedsides at WRNMMC, far from other family members and friends. The donated items – including bibs, diapers, onesies, blankets and stuffed animals – will be part of a delivery to be used for "Wounded Warriors Baby Showers" for eight couples who are expecting in September. The program is organized by the American Red Cross (ARC) and Marines Care, a charitable organization that provides assistance to military members and veterans, as well as their families.
