Later that day on April 30, Mr. Mignogna will moderate a program titled, "Letters, Notes and Napkins: Harmless Error and Writings Intended as Wills." Archer's Anthony R. La Ratta Esq. will be on the panel as well. The program will address the increasing consideration by courts around the country of writings intended as wills and the substantial compliance doctrine – the effect to give wills that do not comply with traditional standards.

May 1: , Mr. Mignogna will moderate a program entitled: "Go Where No Ethics Have Gone Before - Staying on the Right Course in an Expanding Universe of Technology." This program will address the ethical issues which are arising more frequently in technology as used in trust and estate litigation.
