New issues include baseline in the context of extreme weather and climate change. We'll also explore innovative approaches for valuing nature and sustainability. Along those lines we'll have a case study of a consent decree with the City of Seattle for restoration banking.

You'll hear insights from in-house counsel for NRD case management strategies and our annual up-date on trial strategies and techniques. We'll conclude with John Cruden's insights into how NRD practice adapts to new issues and science.
