We are clearly at a turning point, a new frontier, in which residential and commercial developers are required to provide EV charging stations, EDCs are required to provide the “make-ready” infrastructure to allow an EV charging station to be “plugged-in,” and a private company must install and maintain the EV charging station. There are many unanswered questions regarding how a developer, utility, and an EV charging station will integrate and interact, but it is clear that recently enacted law and code require EV charging stations as a percentage of all off street parking spaces for commercial and residential projects. This panel will present the current rules and requirements and will explore the chutes and ladders associated with EV charging infrastructure development in the future.
